TRAVELLING TO JAMAICA WITH A CRIMINAL CONVICTION

Foreign nationals wishing to travel to Jamaica, but who have a criminal record must provide the following documents via e-mail to the Embassy using firstsec@jamaicaembassy.org.

- 1. Letter from applicant requesting permission to travel to Jamaica and indicating intended purpose of travel, length of stay and place of stay in Jamaica.**
- 2. Scanned copy of passport biodata page**
- 3. Court Document detailing the offence as well as the sentenced received**
- 4. If currently on parole, letter from probation officer granting release to travel**

The Embassy will submit the documents on your behalf via e-mail to the relevant authorities in Jamaica for review and a decision. Once a decision is taken, the Embassy will be advised and will inform you accordingly.

The processing time usually takes up to ten (10) business days and **there is no guarantee** that permission will be granted to enter Jamaica.
